



## **RENTAL AGREEMENT ADDENDUM GESA CAROUSEL OF DREAMS ALCOHOL POLICY**

### **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- The client shall designate a responsible, decision-making person which can be consulted by management throughout the event. The individual's name shall be noted below. The named individual shall not become inebriated during the event.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises of the Gesa Carousel of Dreams is a privilege, not a right. Carousel management reserves the right to suspend or completely discontinue the sale and/or service of alcoholic beverages at any event. If this occurs, no refund of facility rental charges will be provided.
- Catering and bartending staff can and will check identification to ensure any guest in possession of any alcoholic beverage is legally able to do so. If applicable, security may also check identification at the door upon entry. No one under the age of 21 will be allowed to possess or consume alcoholic beverages on premises. Guests without identification will not be allowed to consume or possess alcoholic beverages on premises.
- Failure on behalf of a guest(s) to immediately comply with instructions from carousel staff, catering staff or security regarding alcoholic beverages will result in ejection from the facility.
- "Car bars" are not permitted. Any guest found participating in this activity will be denied entry or re-entry to the facility. Because the parking lot is part of a City of Kennewick park, the Kennewick Police Department shall also be notified.
- Carousel management reserves the right to hire security at the client's expense for any event with 25 or more guests in attendance.

### **POURING, SERVING AND CONSUMING**

- Guests will not be allowed to become intoxicated while on premises. Guests that appear intoxicated will not be able to consume or possess any further alcoholic beverages at the event.
- All service of any alcoholic beverage (including wine) must be provided by one of the carousel's existing catering partners. All alcoholic beverages to be consumed on the premises will be served only by M.A.S.T. certified individuals. At no time shall guests pour their own alcohol or bring in an outside bartender, tasting room attendant or other individual to pour and/or serve alcohol.
- While the carousel is open to the general public, alcohol is restricted to the event center only and may not be brought into the carousel room at any time.

- Opened alcoholic beverages, including wine and wine bottles, may not be removed from the premises.

**NON CATERER-PROVIDED ALCOHOL**

- The client and its guests may not bring any open alcoholic beverage onto the premises at any time. Open alcoholic beverages brought into the facility will be confiscated and poured out.
- Donated wine or pre-purchased wine or alcohol to be poured at an event is at the discretion of the caterer providing bartender services. If the caterer permits the client to bring in alcohol, for service or for a raffle or live auction must obtain a Special Occasion License from the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board. Copies of the license must be shared with the caterer, Carousel management and posted at the event during the function. Alcohol provided for raffles and giveaways is not for on-site consumption.
- Alcoholic beverages that remain sealed in baskets or gift boxes for awards, or gift exchanges are allowed. However, removal of the beverage from the sealed basket or box will require its immediate removal from the building.
